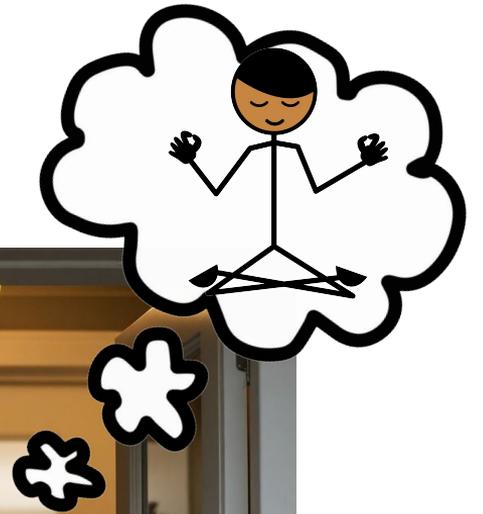
If ICE comes to your house...



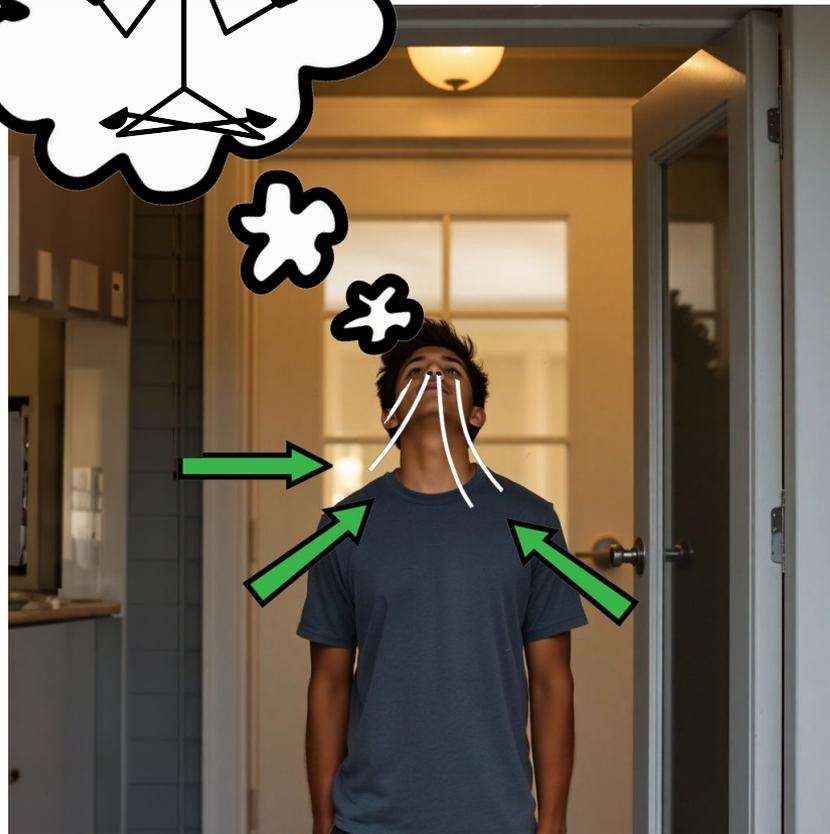
and someone knocks on the door,



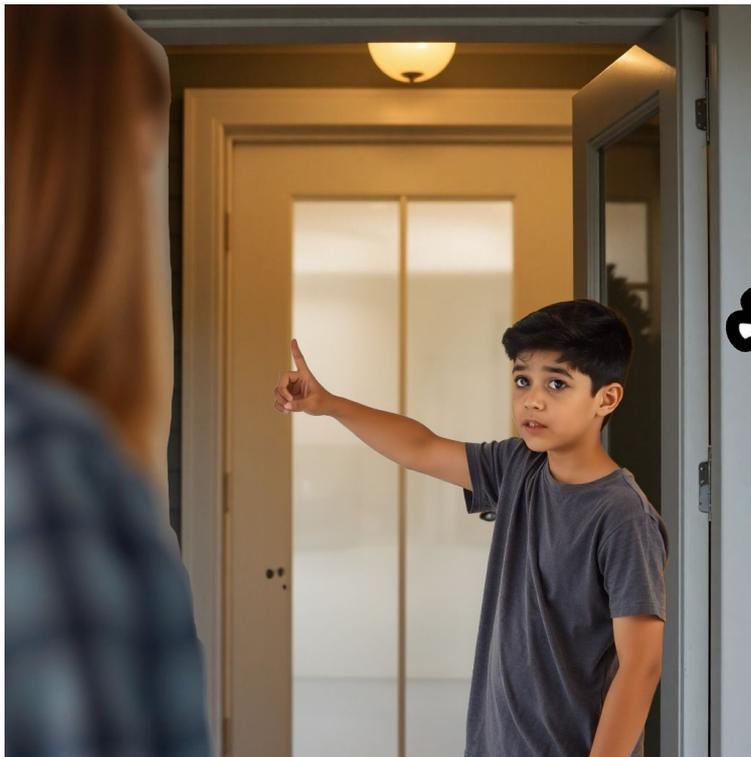
stay calm.

If an adult is not nearby, do not open the door.
Stay quiet and safe.

ICE



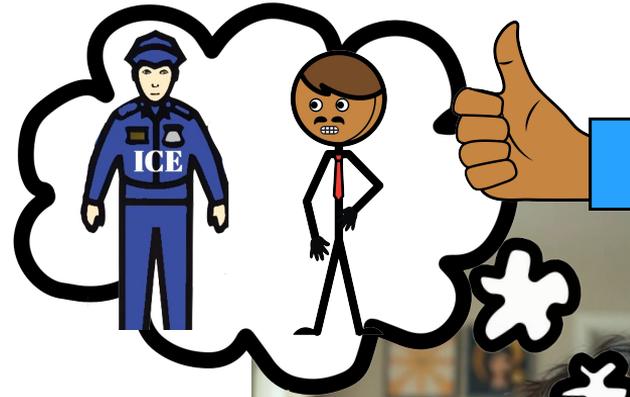
It's okay to stay inside.
